**Southwedge EO Satellite Center :**

**Vision** – Joint initiative with Embracing Options and Bible Baptist Temple similar to Satellite center in Webster. Plan would be to start this center as a volunteer staffed for the first year review at 3,6,9 months to decide if we should pursue funding for a Center Director to be paid by Embracing Options (His Branches).

**Target opening date Spring 2018**

- Occupation of Space, Electric, Phone, use of fax line and printer (for limited needs) and Internet to be donated by Bible Baptist Temple.
- Training of Volunteers, Advertising, Testing Equipment (Pregnancy, STD), client literature and cleaning supplies to be supplied by Embracing Options.
- Desired Hours: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, 12:00 – 5:00

**Prayer:** Daytime Volunteer counselors, Favor with Businesses, Residents and Churches

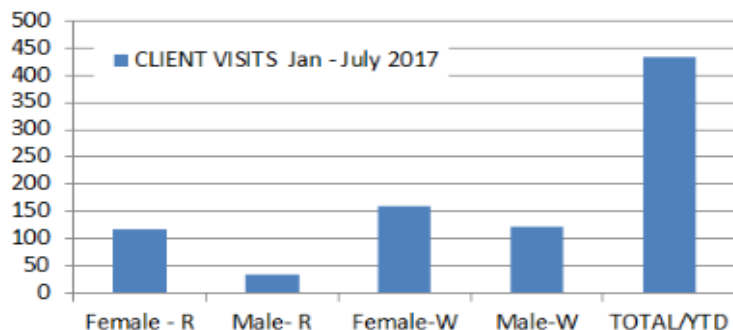

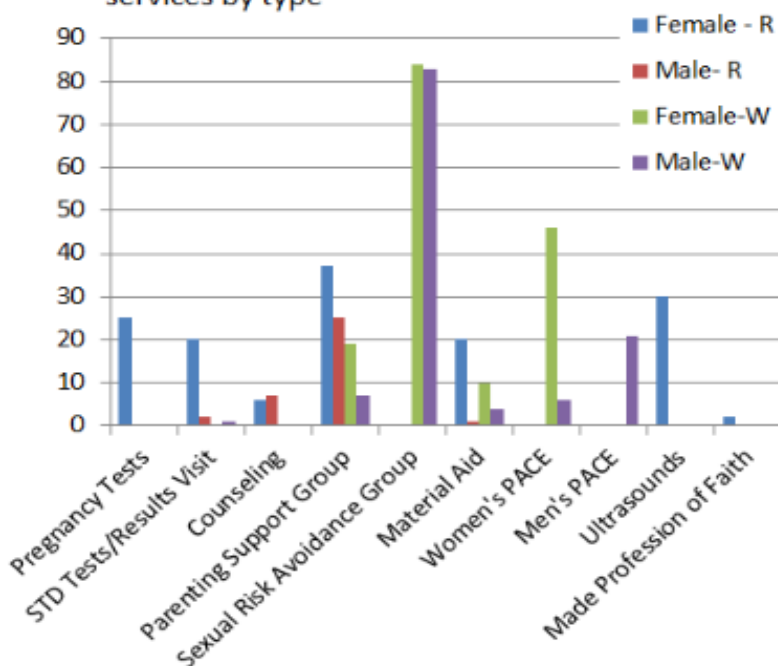

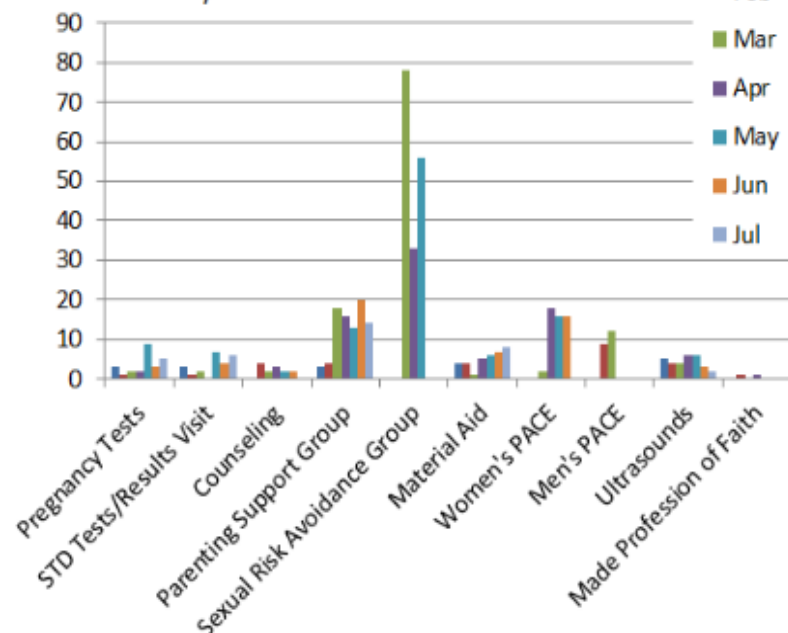
## Client Services Jan - July 2017

## Client Stories

**A 35 year old woman** came in on the last day of July for a pregnancy test. She has 3 children and is going through a divorce but still trying to make her marriage work. She has suffered a lot of tragedy and loss in her life. Her brother was murdered years ago. Her father was a drug dealer and was murdered. Her husband was shot in the head and survived. She herself had multiple abortions in her past. So much loss! The upside of all this tragedy is that she knows the Lord and said she could not have gotten through all of this without him.

These kinds of stories may be shocking to us, but they are not unusual. Many of our clients have family members who were murdered. We need to be an oasis – a place where our clients can come for refreshing truth and love.

**Shocked to hear on the news** that one of our clients was charged with murdering a Rochester Man and will be going to jail. She came to EO not to long ago for material aid. We put out a prayer request and would ask that you pray for her children – that they will be cared for in a safe and loving environment and that the client would turn to Jesus.

**We are excited** to be holding parenting classes for 3 couples at Arnett. Please pray that they will continue to meet with us throughout the pregnancy and beyond.
