ver 33 years ago I made an uninformed decision that would affect me in such a negative way that it left my life destroyed for most of my adult life. At 21, I became pregnant; numbly and ashamed I walked into a PPH center for help. No one ever told me that I was actually carrying a life inside of me and not just a 'blob'. Nor did they offer me alternatives other than abortion. So, I made my appointment, did not tell a soul, and walked in by myself to get things 'taken care of'. Once it was done, I knew in my heart that I had done the most horrific thing, and that I was never going to be able to live with myself... until now!

I had given my life to Jesus Christ 15 years ago, but the guilt, shame and unforgiveness - of myself - never left me. I spent most of my walk with Jesus feeling so unworthy because of what I had done. I knew in my head that He forgave me, but I just could not forgive myself.

Then one day I heard about Embracing Options and the PACE (Post Abortion Counseling Education) course. I so badly wanted to help other women not make the same decision I had made. In order to serve with Embracing Options, I was instructed to take the PACE course, and I praise GOD for that instruction! The most beautiful class fell on my birthday, and I cannot think of a greater gift than my healing! I really had no idea what was buried so deeply within my heart, yet today I am completely healed and set free from my poor decision made so long ago. I no longer punish myself for that mistake, and know within my heart that I will one day see my daughter in heaven. This has given me such peace and joy in my heart. Now I want to give back and help other women become set free by helping out in the PACE course.

Learning to Lament

n January 1984, former President Ronald Reagan began a solemn tradition in our country – Sanctity of Human Life Day. Each year on the Sunday closest to January 22nd, we have the opportunity to collectively mourn the tens of millions of lives that have been lost since the *Roe v. Wade* decision in 1973. This year, Sanctity of Human Life Sunday will be held on January 21st, and we have the opportunity to come before God as the body of Christ to mourn and cry out to God.



Taking time to stop, mourn and pray has long been a spiritual practice and discipline. We see many examples in Scripture in the Old and New Testaments of lament, and our participation can be powerful. 

At Embracing Options, we are blessed to offer Bible studies to help these men and women find hope, help and healing.

The "Forgiven & Set Free" Bible study helps women gain freedom from the bondage of guilt and shame of their abortion experience. The safe and confidential environment, coupled with the study of Scripture, offers help with issues of relief, denial, anger, forgiveness, depression, bondage and acceptance.

"Healing a Father's Heart" Bible study (led by men) frees men from the same experience. It provides men comfort and encouragement on the way to freedom from the emotions that impact their relationships with others - and with God.

And a new Bible study," The Path to Sexual Healing," will be introduced in 2018. Sexual sin leaves in its wake hurting people and scarred lives. Men and women alike need healing from their wounds. This study will help them to discover a deeper knowledge of their standing before God, as well as the grace through which each of us can face the sexual sin that drives us away from wholeness.
